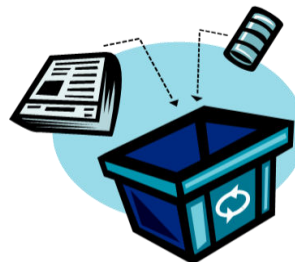

## Accepted Recycling

The following items can be recycled at Recycling Drop Off Sites and Convenience Center Locations:

### Mixed Paper

Newspapers, magazines, office paper, paperboard, cereal boxes, brown paper bags.



### Corrugated Cardboard

Flatten before placing in recycling container.



### Aluminum & Steel Cans

Aluminum foil, pie pans, empty aerosol cans. Cans need to be rinsed with water. (Only at all convenience centers in the onsite scrap metal container.)

## Accepted Items

- Household Garbage
- E-Scrap—TV's, Computers, Monitors, Printers (5 per day)
- Yard Waste
- Construction & Debris
- Used Motor Oil and Filters
- Large Appliances & Scrap Metal
- Furniture and Miscellaneous Items at Swap Shops
- Tires—no more than 5 per day
- Lead Acid & NiCad Batteries
- Textiles/Clothing (at Oakley Road)
- Carpet Padding (at Oakley Road & Charity Church)

## Convenience Center Rules

- No Scavenging; No Loitering
- Only pick-up sized vehicles are allowed.
- Maximum waste accepted at the Convenience Center site is a ½ ton. The ½ ton is considered to be approximately a pick-up load or 10' single-axle trailer load.
- Combinations of pick-up and trailer loads must use the Landfill. Trailers larger than 10' single-axle must also use the Landfill.
- Customers are responsible for unloading and placing waste in proper containers.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Children must be attended to at all times.
- Special Waste Disposal must be coordinated with staff at the Landfill.
- Police have jurisdiction at all sites.
- Swap Shops will accept only items suitable for reuse. Textiles are not accepted in Swap Shops, and they are accepted only in the recycling container at Oakley Road. Swap Shops open at 8:30 am and close at 5:30 pm daily.
- **Recycling is encouraged. Please use the containers provided.**
