## **Traffic Shift Begins Sunday Night for Daniel Island Roundabout**

**BERKELEY COUNTY, S.C.** (**Thursday, May 30, 2019**) – Berkeley County continues work on the Daniel Island roundabout, located at Daniel Island Drive and Seven Farms Drive. Crews will remove the traffic light at the intersection on **Sunday night, June 2.** Traffic will shift to the roundabout configuration by **Monday morning, June 3.** 

There is a message board at the intersection alerting motorists about the traffic shift. Motorists are asked to exercise caution at the roundabout, and watch for pedestrians and construction crews during this time.

Currently, work continues with the curb and sidewalk, as well as planted median on Seven Farms Drive.

Berkeley County started construction on the roundabout on April 22. The project consists of a single-lane roundabout at the intersection.

The project will be complete by early August, prior to the 2019-2020 school year, in an effort to minimize impact to school traffic.

This project is part of the Berkeley County 2014 one-cent sales tax program and is within budget. It is expected to cost approximately \$2.4 million, including design, permitting, right-of-way acquisition and construction.
